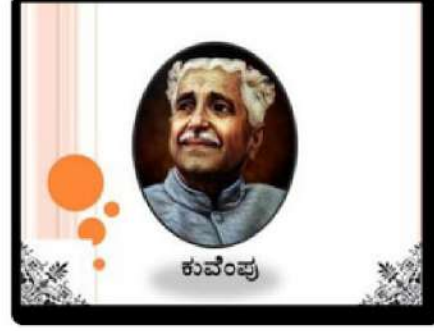

THE KANNADA RAJYOTSAVA, ALSO KNOWN AS KARNATAKA FORMATION DAY OR KARNATAKA DAY, IS A STATE PUBLIC HOLIDAY AND CELEBRATED ON 1 NOVEMBER OF EVERY YEAR. THIS WAS THE DAY IN 1956 WHEN ALL THE KANNADA LANGUAGE-SPEAKING REGIONS OF SOUTH WESTERN INDIA WERE MERGED TO FORM THE STATE OF KARNATAKA. THE 67TH KANNADA RAJYOTSAVA WAS CELEBRATED IN NLLIS WITH GREAT POMP AND SHOW ON 1ST NOVEMBER 2022. MS CHETANA OF GRADE 4B HOSTED THE SHOW. THE PROGRAMME STARTED WITH AUSPICIOUS LAMP LIGHTENING CEREMONY FOLLOWED BY THE INVOCATION DANCE BY THE STUDENTS OF GRADE 4. THE AUDIENCE WERE WELCOMED BY MS NEVIAH OF GRADE 4A. THE STUDENTS OF GRADE 7 PRESENTED AN ENTHRALLING DANCE PERFORMANCE AND THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE STATE FLAG WAS EDIFIED BY MASTER RISHI DHAVAN OF GRADE 4B. STUDENTS OF GRADE 5 AND 6 GAVE A PERFORMANCE ON THE GREAT PERSONALITIES OF KARNATAKA WHO HAS BROUGHT PRIDE AND PRESTIGE TO THE STATE. A SPECIAL PERFORMANCE WAS DELIVERED BY MS BHUVI OF GRADE 2A WHO FILLED THE ATMOSPHERE WITH HER MELODIOUS SONG .THE VOTE OF THANKS WAS PROPOSED BY MASTER HEMANTH OF GRADE-6. NEW LEARNING LADDERS INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL, BANGALORE ORGANISED “RUN FOR UNITY” ON 2ND NOVEMBER 2022 TO COMMEMORATE THE BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST HOME MINISTER AND THE ‘IRON MAN’ OF INDIA, SARDAR VALLABHBHAI PATEL. NATIONAL CONSTITUTION DAY



The National Constitution Day is celebrated on 26th November 1949 when the world's longest-written constitution was duly adopted by the Constituent Assembly of the largest democracy across the globe. Dr BR Ambedkar, along with other members of the Drafting Committee of the Constituent Assembly, including KM Munshi, Muhammed Saadulah, Alladi Krishnaswamy Iyer, Gopala Swami Ayyangar, N Madhava Rao, duly adopted the constitution to commemorate the idea of Purna Swaraj put forth by Nehru in 1928.

Since 2015, November 26 has been observed as Constitution Day or the Samvidhan Diwas to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India by the Constituent Assembly in 1949. Earlier, the day was observed as Law Day. NLLIS celebrated the day with the reading of the Preamble in the Assembly. This was followed by a short speech by the Principal Mrs Ratula Saha who edified the students why constitution and Law is needed and how we are fortunate to be a part of a country that is a Democratic country with a well-drafted constitution. As the day advanced, a Quiz was conducted house wise amongst the shortlisted students from Grade 5 to 10 . After a round of thrilling questions on current affairs, country and famous personalities , the Emerald house was declared the winner.
