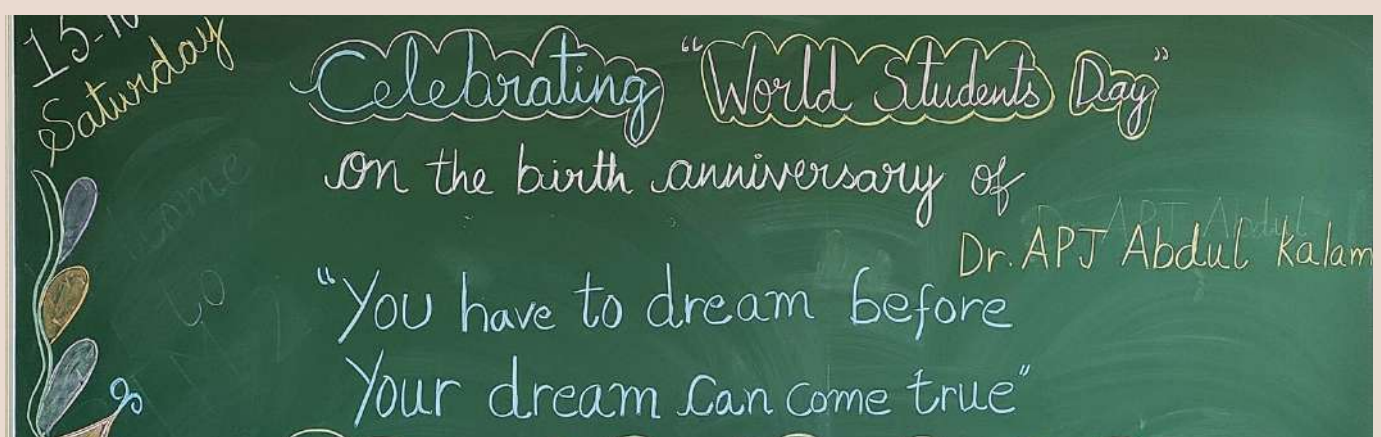
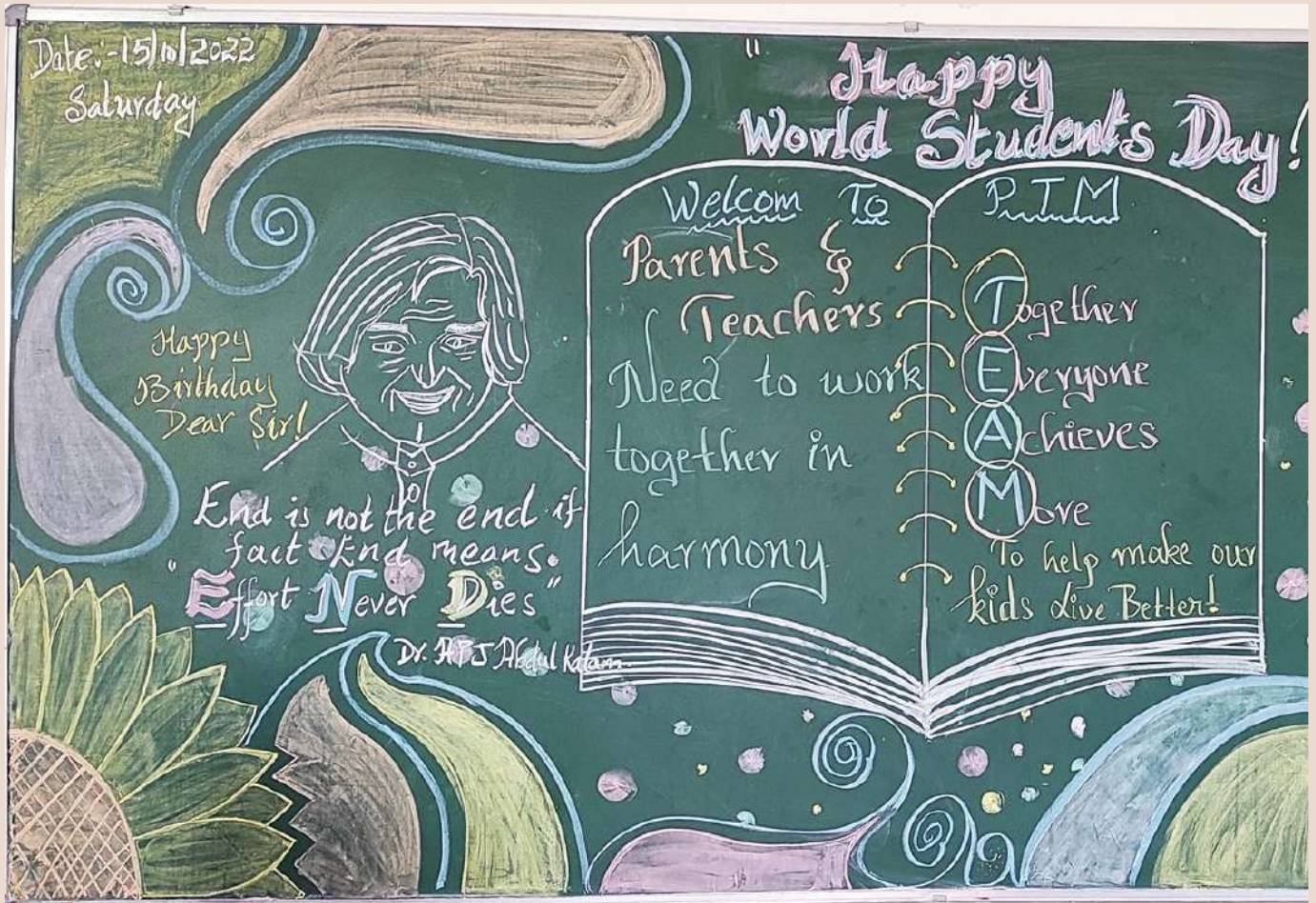


**IF GIGGLES HAD A COLOUR, IT WOULD BE PINK!**
